


# Minnesota West Nile Virus Monitoring, 2008



The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) monitors mosquito populations in four counties in western Minnesota: Big Stone, Ottertail, Traverse, and Wilkin.

MDH no longer routinely tests birds for West Nile virus (WNV) in Minnesota.
