

Health Care Homes (HCH) Initial Certification

CHECKLIST TO BECOMING A CERTIFIED HCH







The following is a list of activities and links to resources which support HCH certification. Primary care providers, clinic teams, and organizations can use one or all steps listed – in any order- as a checklist to prepare for and pursue Foundational Level, Level 2, or Level 3 HCH certification.

Certification Steps for Providers, Clinics, and Organizations

Review HCH program information

- o Home Page: use this page to explore and access HCH content and resources.
- o <u>Certification Eligibility</u>: this page explains who is eligible for HCH certification.
- Certification: here you will find the steps for certification and additional links.
- Level Progression: click here to learn more about advanced certification levels.

Explore the HCH Learning Collaborative

- Learning Collaborative: Access information about HCH learning opportunities.
- HCH E-Learning: Gateway to online courses.
 - "Foundations of Health Care Homes Certification" is a free, on-demand course that takes organizations through the HCH certification process.

- News and Announcements: provides information, updates and opportunities.

Consider <u>Creating an Action Plan for HCH Implementation (PDF)</u>

- The Certification/recertification Operational Manual Providing Application Submission Support (COMPASS (PDF)) outlines the requirements and standards for being a certified HCH.
- Use <u>COMPASS Appendix A (PDF)</u> to review each standard's requirements, identifying those already being met and those which still need to be addressed.
 - To see related definitions, explanations and examples for a specific requirement:
 - Go to the table of contents.
 - Click on that requirement.
 - You will be directed to content within COMPASS accordingly.

■ Email the HCH program (Health.HealthCareHomes@state.mn.us)

- o Express your interest in HCH certification and request to be connected with a RN.
- Your Practice Improvement Specialist (PIS) will contact you.
- o They will be there to support you during the entire process.

Meet with your PIS

- o Review the HCH standards, requirements, and certification levels.
- Discuss available resources to assist with certification.
- Ask questions.
- Establish access to the HCH Portal.

Log into the HCH <u>Public Portal (mn.gov)</u>

- This is where you will complete the Certification application.
- The Portal User Guide (PDF): step-by-step instructions for online documentation.
- The HCH <u>Application (PDF)</u>: may be downloaded for planning purposes.

Begin the application process using available resources

See above resources and links.

Submit the application

o Once submitted, your PIS will work with you to schedule a Site Visit/Team Meeting.

Host a Site Visit Team Meeting

 <u>COMPASS Appendix D (PDF)</u> contains detailed information regarding the Site Visit/Team Meeting.

Next Steps Completed by MDH

Final Report

 Your PIS will compose a written, final report summarizing the highlights of your application, site visit, and any recommendations or variances.

Certification Committee

- After providing the written report to the HCH Certification Committee, your PIS will present your organization (de-identified) to the committee.
- The committee will review all information presented and determine if the standards and requirements for the level of certification applied for have been met.

MDH Notification

- o Certification Notification: this page explains how MDH determines certification.
- All certification documents will be made available both electronically and via mail.
- Window clings, reflecting level of certification obtained, will be sent for posting at clinic entrances.

Maintenance Steps for the certified HCH and Other Reminders

Stay Connected to the MDH HCH program

- Be sure to keep your HCH program contacts up to date and let your PIS know of any staff changes.
- Use the links at the bottom of the <u>News and Announcements</u> webpage to sign up for the HCH Connection Newsletter and HCH LEARN Bulletin. Ensure all new staff and any current staff who haven't yet done so receive these important notifications.

Update certified clinician list in the portal as needed.

o Portal User Guide (PDF): step by step instructions for updating the Clinician List.

Orient New Staff to HCH

 It is the organization's responsibility to orient new clinicians and staff to the HCH's care delivery approach. The HCH <u>Learning Collaborative</u> is a great resource for this as well as your PIS.

MDH HCH Check-ins

 Your PIS will offer a voluntary Check-In every 12 to 18 months, as an opportunity to discuss your HCH program, organizational priorities, and ways the HCH program can be of support.

Participate in the HCH Learning Collaborative

 Take advantage of full access to the HCH Learning Collaborative, including select events reserved for our certified partners.
