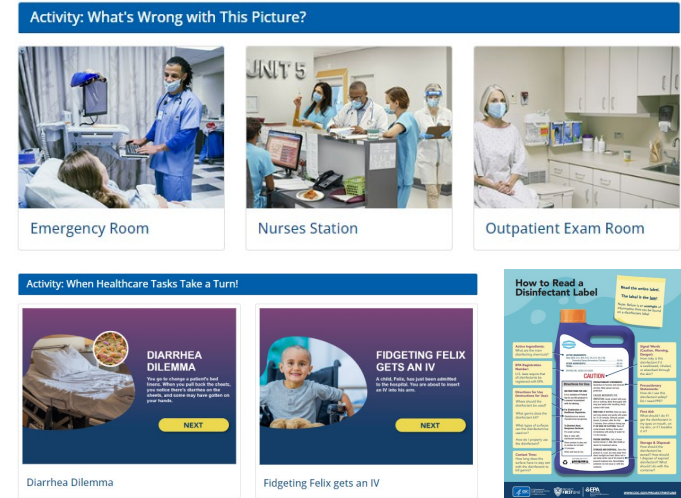


Minnesota Department of Health Project Firstline
