

Rural Hospital Capital Improvement Grant FY 2025 Frequently Asked Questions

Can you confirm the deadline for the application?

The deadline to apply is 4:30pm CT on Friday, December 20, 2024.

Does our organization need to have a 501(c)(3) designation to be eligible for this grant?

State Statute requires that organizations for this award need to be not-for-profit and have a 501(c)(3) designation or be a Critical Access Hospital (CAH) and be operated by a city or county.

Are hospitals who are licensed for over 50 beds but staff under 50 beds eligible for this grant?

No- hospitals must have less than 50 beds to be eligible for the Rural Hospital Capital Improvement grant.

Will the Capital Improvement Grant RFP information webinar be recorded?

No- however materials from the webinar, including presentation slides and a questions and answers document, will be posted on the [ORHPC webpage](#).

Are we eligible to submit a proposal for the FY25 Capital Improvement grant even if we have an ongoing Rural Hospital Capital Improvement grant project and award?

Yes- an eligible applicant can submit a new proposal for FY25 even if they have an ongoing project with a Rural Hospital Capital Improvement grant award, as long as the proposed project for FY25 is not additional funding for the ongoing Rural Hospital Capital Improvement grant project.

Is the Governing Board Resolution still required in the application?

No- the Governing Board Resolution is no longer a required attachment for the FY25 Rural Hospital Capital Improvement grant application.
